- The Washington State Department of Health and Safeway have “Kicked-Off” [Complete Eats](#), a **program that makes fruits and vegetables more affordable for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) customers.** Complete Eats rewards customers who purchase fruits and vegetables with SNAP benefits (formerly called Food Stamps) with coupons and rebates. Shoppers at Safeway who buy at least \$10 worth of qualifying fruits and vegetables using their SNAP card and their Safeway Club Card receive a coupon for \$5 off their next purchase. Complete Eats is now available at all 150 Safeway locations in Washington.
