

SUMMARY OF HEALTH EDUCATION MATERIAL INVENTORY: KHMER LANGUAGE MATERIALS

Overview

This inventory was completed by the Seattle regional site of the Asian American Network for Cancer Awareness, Research, and Training (AANCART). Therefore, the main focus was health education materials related to cancer control. However, during the process, health education materials related to other medical issues (e.g., diabetes and tuberculosis) were also collected and inventoried. We took a national approach to the search which involved telephone and Email correspondence as well as Internet-based searches.

Cancer Education Topics

The following topics were considered relevant to cancer education during our search for materials:

- Breast cancer – breast self-examination (BSE), clinical breast examination (CBE), mammography
- Cervical cancer – Papanicolaou (Pap) testing
- Colorectal cancer – fecal occult blood testing (FOBT), colonoscopy, sigmoidoscopy
- Diet and nutrition
- Liver cancer – hepatitis B testing and immunization
- Prostate cancer – prostate specific antigen (PSA) testing
- Tobacco cessation
- Regular physical examinations

General Approach

The initial steps included contacting “primary” potential sources of Khmer language materials. Primary sources included national offices of health care organizations, national offices of Asian American service groups, health departments in states that were known to have significant Cambodian populations, institutions represented on the AANCART steering committee, and academic groups that have published articles addressing cancer control in Cambodian communities. Academic groups were identified through a comprehensive Medline search. Internet-based searches were also conducted using a combination of the words “Asian American,” “cancer,” “health education,” “Cambodian/Khmer,” and “translated material” (Table 1). Through these “primary” sources, we were also referred to multiple “secondary” potential sources of Khmer language materials (Table 2).

Limitations

This inventory has several limitations that should be recognized. These limitations are summarized below.

- The inventory was compiled between July 2000 and October 2000; Khmer language materials continue to be changed and developed over time.
- It is probable that we were unaware of some organizations that have developed relevant cancer education materials.
- The inventory of other health education materials is certainly incomplete because we made no systematic effort to inventory non-cancer related materials. For example, organizations such as the American Diabetes Association were not contacted.
- We have made no effort to review the materials for content, literacy level, translation quality, or reproduction quality.
- While photocopies of most print material have been provided with this inventory, individual organizations should be contacted prior to copying and distributing any of the material. Some agencies may have copies available for distribution.
